20	WHEREAS, on March 5, 2025, Bonnie Pollock, who has been an educator for
21	twelve (12) years, received a prestigious Milken Educator Award and its
22	accompanying prize of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000); and

24	WHEREAS, Bonnie Pollock currently teaches grade six (6) at Old High
25	Middle School in Bentonville, Arkansas; and
26	
27	WHEREAS, the Milken Educator Award, also known as the "Oscars of
28	Teaching", is always presented in a surprise ceremony for recipients because
29	educators do not apply for the award but instead are confidentially
30	recommended to the Milken Family Foundation by a blue-ribbon panel appointed
31	by each state's department of education; and

33	WHEREAS, in addition to the prize of twenty-five thousand dollars
34	(\$25,000), recipients of the Milken Educator Award are paired with veteran
35	Milken Educator Award recipients as part of the mentorship program Milken
36	Friends Forever; and

1 2 WHEREAS, Bonnie Pollock has been invited to attend the annual Milken 3 Educator Awards Forum in Los Angeles, California, in April 2025; and 4 5 WHEREAS, Bonnie Pollock is known for having a transformative classroom, 6 fostering collaboration, and propelling student growth; and 7 8 WHEREAS, Bonnie Pollock said of her students, "Last year, Arkansas did the first Civics Bee and I had five of the nine finalists at state from my 9 10 sixth-grade class. I [taught] sixth grade literacy and social studies last 11 year, so that was just a way to connect social studies and writing to a real-12 world thing"; and 13 14 WHEREAS, Secretary of the Department of Education Jacob Oliva said of 15 Bonnie Pollock's win, "We're talking about the great work that's happening in 16 the State of Arkansas that has been recognized at a national level. For our 17 teachers' names to go across the finish line is saying you're not only just 18 great in the State of Arkansas, but you're one of the greatest teachers in 19 the nation. It's something that we're very proud to be a part of"; and 20 21 WHEREAS, Bonnie Pollock said of her win, "I'm very shocked and 22 overwhelmed . . .
