18	WHEREAS, the De Queen High School Lady Leopards basketball team won the
19	Class 4A state championship held at Bank OZK Arena in Hot Springs, Arkansas,
20	on March 14, 2025; and

22	WHEREAS, this was the second state championship title for the Lady
23	Leopards, and their first since 2003; and

25	WHEREAS, the Lady Leopards defeated the previously undefeated Pulaski
26	Academy Lady Bruins by a score of sixty-two (62) to fifty-four (54) to win
27	the state championship; and

29	WHEREAS, the Lady Leopards finished the season with a record of thirty-
30	five wins and one loss (35-1), setting a record for the most wins in a single
31	season in school history; and

33	WHEREAS, the Lady Leopards had fifteen (15) steals and forced twenty
34	(20) turnovers in the championship game, and they converted these into twenty
35	(20) points; and
