9	(A) One (1) food pantry in their district; and
10	(B) One (1) school in their district during School
11	Breakfast Month;
12	(3) Work to develop and enact policies to address the issue of
13	food insecurity in addition to universal breakfast for public school
14	children; and
15	(4) Monitor and evaluate data related to actions taken by the
16	General Assembly in moving the needle on food insecurity in Arkansas.
