11 THE GULF COAST HIGH INTENSITY DRUG TRAFFICKING AREA

16 TO RECOGNIZE THE DIVISION OF ARKANSAS  
17 STATE POLICE'S INTERSTATE CRIMINAL  
18 PATROL FOR WINNING TOP HONORS AT THE  
19 GULF COAST HIGH INTENSITY DRUG  
20 TRAFFICKING AREA AWARDS.

22 WHEREAS, the Division of Arkansas State Police's Interstate Criminal  
23 Patrol team received multiple accolades at the Gulf Coast High Intensity Drug  
24 Trafficking Area Awards held on April 1, 2025, in Biloxi, Mississippi; and  
25

26 WHEREAS, the Division of Arkansas State Police's Interstate Criminal  
27 Patrol team was recognized as the 2024 Agency of the Year because of  
28 successful seizure of illegal narcotics with a street value of thirty-two  
29 million, two hundred fifty thousand, four hundred seventy-six dollars  
30 (\$32,250,476), confiscation of twenty-five (25) vehicles, and recovery of  
31 four million, one hundred thousand dollars (\$4,100,000) in cash; and

33 WHEREAS, Trooper Ana Escamilla of the Division of Arkansas State  
34 Police's Interstate Criminal Patrol team was named 2024 Officer of the Year  
35 for netting twenty-one (21) drug seizures and seven (7) currency seizures  
36 amounting to a combined street value of four million, nine hundred eighty-



1 four thousand, eight hundred eighty-four dollars (\$4,984,884) and for making  
2 twenty-seven (27) arrests, seizing seven (7) vehicles, and confiscating two  
3 (2) weapons; and

5 WHEREAS, Corporal Chris Short of the Division of Arkansas State  
6 Police's Interstate Criminal Patrol team was recognized for the 2024 Largest  
7 Cash Seizure, which totaled eight hundred thirteen thousand, four hundred  
8 ninety dollars (\$813,490) and was made during a single traffic stop in  
9 Crawford County, Arkansas; and  
10

11 WHEREAS, the Division of Arkansas State Police's Interstate Criminal  
12 Patrol team was also recognized in 2022 and 2023 as the Team of the Year, and  
13 this was the third consecutive year a team member was named Officer of the  
14 Year; and  
15

16 WHEREAS, Director of the Division of Arkansas State Police Colonel Mike  
17 Hagar said of the wins, "I am extremely proud of the exemplary work our  
18 troopers assigned to the ICP teams perform every day to safeguard the public  
19 from those who traffic illegal narcotics in our state. These awards emphasize  
20 the ICP's commitment to aggressively combat drug trafficking and criminal  
21 activities on Arkansas's interstates and highways",

23 NOW THEREFORE,

24 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-FIFTH GENERAL  
25 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

27 THAT the House of Representatives recognize the Division of Arkansas  
28 State Police's Interstate Criminal Patrol for winning top honors at the Gulf  
29 Coast High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area Awards.
