28	(a) As used in this section:	
29	(1) "Child" means a natural child, a stepchild, or a	<u>n adoptive</u>
30	child of an employee; and	
31	(2) "Immediate family" means the father, mother, sis	ter,
32	brother, husband, wife, child, grandmother, grandfather, grandchi	ld, in-laws,
33	or any individual acting as parent or guardian of an employee.	
34	(b)(1) Except as provided under subdivision (b)(2) of this	section, an
35	employee shall be granted eighty (80) hours of leave during any o	<u>ne (1)</u>
36	calendar year in the event of the death of an immediate family me	mber.



1	(2) An employee shall be granted six hundred forty (640) hours
2	of leave during any one (1) calendar year in the event of the death of a
3	child.
4	(c)(l) Unused leave without pay granted under this section shall not
5	be carried over to the next calendar year.
6	(2) Upon termination or retirement, leave without pay granted
7	under this section is not compensable to the employee.
