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21	SECTION 1. Arka	nsas Code § 10-3-309(f), concern	ing authorization for a

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29	SECTION 2. Arkan	sas Code Title 15, Chapter 23, S	ubchapter l, is amended

32	<u>water — Definition.</u>		
33	(a) As used in	this section, "moratorium" means	a prohibition on the
34	issuance of permits or	any other limitation on agricul	tural production,
35	including without limi	tation, livestock and poultry op	erations, contained
36	animal feeding operati	ons, and the cultivation of crop	s and orchards.

1	(b) Except as provided in subsection (c) of this section, a state
2	agency, including without limitation the Department of Agriculture and the
3	Department of Energy and Environment, shall not institute a moratorium on the
4	issuance of permits in a watershed or other body of water.
5	(c)(1) In order for a state agency to institute a moratorium related
6	to a watershed or other body of water, the state agency shall:
7	(A) Promulgate a rule to institute the moratorium;
8	(B)(i) Follow the procedure under the Arkansas
9	Administrative Procedure Act, § 25-15-201 et seq.
10	(ii) If the Arkansas Administrative Procedure Act, §
11	25-15-201 et seq., does not apply to the state agency, the state agency shall
12	follow the law governing the adequate administrative procedures for the state
13	agency; and
14	(C) Obtain review and approval of the state agency rule
15	<u>under § 10-3-309.</u>
16	(2)(A) A moratorium reviewed and approved under subdivision
17	(c)(1) of this section shall expire four (4) years after the effective date
18	of the rule.
19	(B) A state agency that wishes to continue a moratorium
20	shall submit the moratorium to the Legislative Council for review and
21	approval sufficiently in advance of the expiration date described under
22	subdivision (c)(2)(A) of this section to continue the moratorium.
23	(C) If the state agency fails to submit a moratorium to
24	the Legislative Council for review and approval prior to the expiration date
25	or if the Legislative Council does not approve the moratorium, the moratorium
26	shall expire at the expiration date.
27	(d) This section does not prohibit a state agency from seeking review
28	and approval for a proposed emergency rule under § 10-3-309 and § 25-15-204
29	to impose a moratorium to protect the public from imminent peril to the
30	public health, safety, or welfare or compliance with a federal law or
31	regulation.
32	(e) If a state agency does not have statutory authority to impose a
33	moratorium, this section does not create the authority for a moratorium.
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35	SECTION 3. DO NOT CODIFY. Existing moratoriums.
36	(a) A moratorium related to a watershed or other body of water

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1	instituted before the effective date of this act shall go through the rule
2	review and approval process required under § 15-23-107(c) within ninety (90)
3	days of the effective date of this act to remain enforceable.
4	(b) If a state agency does not submit the moratorium for review and
5	approval as required by subsection (a) of this section, the moratorium
6	related to a watershed or other body of water instituted before the effective
7	date of this act shall expire immediately.
8	(c) If a moratorium related to a watershed or other body of water
9	instituted before the effective date of this act is not approved under § 15-
10	23-107(c), the moratorium shall expire immediately.
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12	SECTION 4. DO NOT CODIFY. Effective date.
13	This act shall be effective on and after January 1, 2026.
