21	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 20, Chapter 56, Subchapt	ter 3, is
22	amended to add an additional section to read as follows:	
23	<u>20-56-309. Testing of processed marijuana product — De</u>	finition.
24	(a)(1) As used in this section, "processed marijuana pr	roduct" means a
25	marijuana product intended for human consumption that has been	n altered from
26	the usable marijuana under the Arkansas Medical Marijuana Amer	ndment of 2016,
27	Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 98, by extraction, concentrat	tion,
28	encapsulation, chemical manipulation, or other process.	
29	(2) "Processed marijuana product" includes without	<u>ut limitation</u>
30	edibles, oils, concentrations, tinctures, topicals, inhalables	s, and other
31	forms of marijuana that have been infused or processed.	
32	(3)(A) "Processed marijuana product" is separate	and distinct
33	from marijuana paraphernalia that requires the combustion of r	<u>marijuana to be</u>
34	properly utilized, including pipes, water pipes, bongs, chille	ums, rolling
35	papers, and roach clips.	
36	(B) "Processed marijuana product" is not su	<u>ubject to</u>



1	prohibitions that are applicable to paraphernalia.
2	(b) All processed marijuana products shall be tested after being fully
3	processed and in the form of a finished product suitable for packaging.
4	(c) The testing under this section shall comply with the rules of the
5	Department of Health and include without limitation the testing of:
6	(1) Pesticides;
7	(2) Heavy metals;
8	(3) Microbiological contaminants;
9	(4) Residual solvents; and
10	(5) Concentrations of tetrahydrocannabinol and cannabidiol.
