1	(B) <u>(i)</u> A method typically used by a primary care team	
2	consisting of a primary care provider and a care manager who works in	
3	collaboration with a psychiatric consultant, including without limitation a	
4	psychiatrist.	
5	(ii)(a) A primary care team under subdivision	
6	(a)(2)(B)(i) of this section may include an individual providing clinical	
7	psychiatric pharmacist services if the individual:	
8	(1) Possesses a pharmacy degree	
9	from a program accredited by the Accreditation Council for Pharmacy	
10	Education;	
11	(2) Utilizes a protocol of disease	
12	state management as defined under § 17-92-101 with a supervising provider or
