SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 24 25 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY 26 FORWARD - NEW HIRE REGISTRY. Any balance in the funds made available by this 27 Act for the New Hire Registry which remain on June 30, 2025 2026, may be 28 carried forward into the next fiscal year, to be used for the same purpose. 29 Any carry forward of unexpended balance of funding as authorized herein, 30 may be carried forward under the following conditions: 31 (1) Prior to June 30, 2025 2026 the Agency shall by written statement 32 set forth its reason(s) for the need to carry forward said funding to the Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget; 33 34 (2) The Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget shall 35 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council all amounts carried forward by the 36 September Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee meeting

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which report shall include the name of the Agency, Board, Commission or
 Institution and the amount of the funding carried forward, the program name
 or line item, the funding source of that appropriation and a copy of the
 written request set forth in (1) above;

5 (3) Each Agency, Board, Commission or Institution shall provide a 6 written report to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee 7 containing all information set forth in item (2) above, along with a written 8 statement as to the current status of the project, contract, purpose etc. for 9 which the carry forward was originally requested no later than thirty (30) 10 days prior to the time the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution presents 11 its budget request to the Arkansas Legislative Council/Joint Budget 12 Committee; and

13 (4) Thereupon, the Department of Finance and Administration shall 14 include all information obtained in item (3) above in the budget manuals 15 and/or a statement of non-compliance by the Agency, Board, Commission or 16 Institution.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2024
<u>2025</u> through June 30, 2025 <u>2026</u>.

20 SECTION 19. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 21 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. EXTRA 22 HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Division of Workforce Services for 23 the 2024-2025 2025-2026 fiscal year, the following maximum number of part-24 time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds 25 appropriated herein for such purposes: four hundred thirty three fifty(433) 26 (50) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to 27 exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or 28 its successor, for the appropriate classification. Any of these positions 29 utilized in a manner which are funded by federal sources are specifically 30 exempt from limitation of hours, either by Act or Regulation.

In order to comply with the timeliness requirements set forth by the Social Security Act, the Chairman of the Board of Review is authorized to utilize part-time or temporary employees from the pool of positions provided to the Division of Workforce Services in any occurrence where the number of appeals to the Board of Review or Appeal Tribunal increases above a level that can be resolved by the permanent staff in a timely manner. The Division

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of Workforce Services will determine the appropriate funding source within
 the Department for said positions.

3 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2024
4 <u>2025</u> through June 30, 2025 <u>2026</u>.

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6 SECTION 20. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 7 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER 8 OF APPROPRIATION. Subject to such rules and regulations as may be 9 implemented by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and after having sought 10 the prior approval by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget 11 Committee, the Director of the Division of Workforce Services is hereby 12 authorized to make transfers from any appropriation made by this Act to any 13 other appropriation made by this Act with the exception of the "Reed Act 14 Funds" appropriations set forth in the Reed Act Funds appropriation section 15 of this Act, and of the appropriation made for Regular Salaries or 16 Maintenance and General Operation. Such transfers may be made whenever it 17 appears, by projecting the expenditures of any of the appropriations in this 18 Act, that there will be a deficiency of appropriation in one item and that 19 there will be a corresponding excess of appropriation in another item or 20 items which may be transferred. The transfer of appropriation shall be 21 effected only on approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State. Provided, 22 however, that no transfer of appropriations may be authorized to increase the 23 total amount appropriated for Regular Salaries, or Maintenance and General 24 Operations, except as may be authorized elsewhere by law.

25 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of 26 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year 27 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by 28 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by 29 30 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly 31 has determined that the Division of Workforce Services may operate more 32 efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Division of Workforce 33 Services authorizing broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is both 34 necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by 35 requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee 36 as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative

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Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section.
 If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget
 Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction,
 this entire section is void.

5 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2024
6 <u>2025</u> through June 30, 2025 <u>2026</u>.

8 SECTION 21. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 9 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRAINING 10 TRUST FUND TRANSFER. Immediately upon the effective date of this Act, the 11 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall transfer on his or her books and 12 those of the State Treasurer and the Auditor of the State the sum of up to 13 two million five hundred thousand dollars (\$2,500,000) from the Division of 14 Workforce Services Training Trust Fund to the Skills Development Fund. 15 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2024 16 2025 through June 30, 2025 2026.

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18 SECTION 22. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 19 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FEDERAL 20 MATCHING. The funds appropriated in Sections for Adult Basic and General 21 Adult Education of this Act may also be used to match any available federal 22 funds from any agency in order to provide the maximum amount of money 23 possible for the purposes enumerated in such Section.

24 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2024
25 <u>2025</u> through June 30, 2025 <u>2026</u>.

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27 SECTION 23. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 28 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. ADULT 29 EDUCATION DISTRIBUTION. All funds that become available for Adult Education shall be distributed to those administrative units determined to be operating 30 31 efficient adult education programs, under criteria established by the 32 Division of Workforce Services. The criteria shall include the relative 33 efficiency of administration of the program in the counties served and 34 achievement of federal performance indicators. The Division of Workforce 35 Services shall promulgate rules and regulations for the distribution of funds 36 in accordance with criteria to be determined by the Board. In the

1 distribution of funds to local units the Board shall consider performance in 2 meeting state and federal performance indicators. Unallocated funds will be 3 redistributed based upon need as determined by the Division of Workforce 4 Services.

5 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2024
6 2025 through June 30, 2025 2026.

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8 SECTION 24. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 9 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 10 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 11 12 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 13 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 14 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 15 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 16 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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SECTION 25. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 18 19 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 20 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 21 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 22 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 23 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 24 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 25 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 26

27 SECTION 26. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits 28 29 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the 30 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2025 is essential to the operation of 31 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 32 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2025 could work irreparable harm 33 34 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 35 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act 36 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health

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
