19	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 1-4-133 is amended to read as follows:
20	1-4-133. Display of national motto <u>— Display of the Ten Commandments</u> .
21	(a)(1) If funds under subsection (b) of this section are available,
22	local school <u>district</u> superintendents, local <u>government</u> building
23	administrators, or chief administrators of the public schools in this state,
24	or institutions of higher education, or their respective designees, and the
25	administrative officials of state agencies, or their respective designees,
26	shall prominently display the following in a conspicuous place in a location
27	described in subdivision (a)(2) of this section a durable poster or framed
28	copy containing:
29	(A)(i) The <u>A durable poster or framed copy of the</u> national
30	motto of the United States, "In God We Trust".
31	(ii) The national motto shall:
32	(a) Be easily readable on a poster or framed
33	copy of at least eleven inches by fourteen inches (11" x 14");
34	(b) Be the central focus of the poster or
35	framed copy; and
36	(c) Be displayed in a large font size;

1	(B) An accurate representation of the United States flag,
2	which shall be under the national motto; and
3	(C) An accurate representation of the Arkansas state flag
4	or flags; and
5	(D)(i) A durable poster or framed copy of the Ten
6	Commandments.
7	(ii) The durable poster or framed copy of the Ten
8	Commandments required by subdivision (a)(l)(D)(i) of this section shall:
9	(a) Include the text of the Ten Commandments
10	in a size and typeface that is legible to a person with average vision from
11	anywhere in the room in which the durable poster or framed copy is displayed;
12	and
13	(b) Be at least sixteen inches by twenty
14	<u>inches (16" x 20").</u>
15	(iii) The text of the durable poster or framed copy
16	of the Ten Commandments shall read as follows:
17	"The Ten Commandments
18	I am the Lord thy God.
19	Thou shalt have no other gods before me.
20	Thou shalt not make to thyself any graven images.
21	Thou shalt not take the Name of the Lord thy God in vain.
22	Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy.
23	Honor thy father and thy mother, that thy days may be long upon the land
24	which the Lord thy God giveth thee.
25	Thou shalt not kill.
26	Thou shalt not commit adultery.
27	Thou shalt not steal.
28	Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbor.
29	Thou shalt not covet thy neighbor's house.
30	Thou shalt not covet thy neighbor's wife, nor his manservant, nor his
31	maidservant, nor his cattle, nor anything that is thy neighbor's.".
32	(2) The durable posters or framed copies donated or purchased
33	under subdivision (a)(l) of this section shall be displayed in each:
34	(A) Public institution of higher education and elementary
35	and secondary school library and classroom in this state; and
36	(B) Public building or facility in this state that is

1 maintained or operated by taxpayer funds.

(b) The copies or posters authorized under required by this section shall either be donated or shall be purchased solely with funds made available through voluntary contributions to the local school district boards of directors, local building governing entity, or the Building Authority Division. (c) If a copy or poster required under this section does not meet the requirements of subsection (a) of this section, then an institution specified under subsection (a) of this section may replace the copy or poster with a copy or poster that meets the requirements of subsection (a) of this section: (1) With <u>public funds; or</u> (2) By accepting a private donation. (d) If an institution specified under subsection (a) of this section has a copy or poster that is not needed for display, then the institution specified under subsection (a) of this section shall donate the copy or poster to another institution specified under subsection (a) of this section.
