19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 5, Chapter 60, Subchapter 1, is amend	ed
22	to add an additional section to read as follows:	
23	5-60-126. Purchase or possession of an e-liquid or a vapor product by	y
24	<u>a minor.</u>	
25	(a) As used in this section:	
26	(1) "E-liquid product" means a liquid, which may contain	
27	nicotine, that is inhaled when using a vapor product, and that may include	
28	without limitation propylene glycol, vegetable glycerin, nicotine from any	
29	source, and flavorings;	
30	(2)(A) "Minor" means a person who is under twenty-one (21) year	<u>rs</u>
31	of age.	
32	(B) "Minor" does not include a person who is under twent	<u>y -</u>
33	one years of age and presents a military identification card establishing	
34	that he or she is a member of the United States Armed Forces; and	
35	(3)(A) "Vapor product" means an electronic oral device of any	
36	size or shape that contains a vapor of nicotine, e-liquid product, or any

1	other substance that when used or inhaled simulates smoking, regardless of
2	whether a visible vapor is produced, including without limitation a device
3	that:
4	(i) Is composed of a heating element, battery,
5	electronic circuit, chemical process, mechanical device, or a combination of
6	a heating element, a battery, an electronic circuit, a chemical process, or a
7	mechanical device;
8	(ii) Works in combination with a cartridge, other
9	container, or liquid delivery device containing nicotine, an e-liquid
10	product, or another substance that is manufactured for use with a vapor
11	product; and
12	(iii) Is manufactured, distributed, marketed, or
13	sold as any type or derivation of a vapor product, an e-cigarette, an e-
14	cigar, an e-pipe, or another product that is similar to a vapor product.
15	(B) "Vapor product" does not include a product regulated
16	as a drug or device by the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act, 21 U.S.C. §
17	301 et seq., as it existed on January 1, 2025.
18	(b) It is unlawful for a minor to purchase or possess an e-liquid
19	product or a vapor product.
20	(c) An officer that seizes an e-liquid product or a vapor product
21	found in the possession of a minor shall destroy the item or dispose of the
22	item as contraband under § 5-5-101.
23	(d) Purchase or possession of an e-liquid product or a vapor product
24	by a minor is a violation and is punishable by a fine not to exceed one
25	hundred dollars (\$100) or up to twenty (20) hours of community service work,
26	<u>or both.</u>
27	(e) It is not a violation of this section if the minor was acting
28	<u>under § 5-27-227(c).</u>
