21	SECTION 1. Ar	kansas Code § 23-4-1306(e)(1), as enacted	by Acts 2025,
22	No. 373, § 16, conce	erning an order approving a rider rate sch	edule under the

33	SECTION 2. EM	ERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determin	ed by the
34	General Assembly of	the State of Arkansas that the General As	sembly passed
35	<u>Acts 2025, No. 373,</u>	to allow for significant investment in el	<u>ectric public</u>
36	<u>utility infrastructu</u>	are and natural gas public utility infrast	ructure to



1	enable this state to attract and serve economic development projects across a		
2	variety of industries, as well as to continue reliably supporting existing		
3	and new customers; that an engrossing error was discovered during the review		
4	of Acts 2025, No. 373; and that this act is immediately necessary to correct		
5	the engrossing error found during the review of Acts 2025, No. 373.		
6	Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this act being immediately		
7	necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall		
8	become effective on:		
9	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;		
10	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,		
11	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the		
12	<u>bill; or</u>		
13	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is		
14	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
