21	WAIVE THE "REASONABLE ASSURANCE" CLAUSE.
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23	WHEREAS, under the Federal Unemployment Tax Act, certain employees of
24	educational institutions are not eligible for compensation for any week
25	during a period between two (2) academic years if the employee performs
26	services in the first of the academic years and if there is a contract or
27	reasonable assurance that the employee will perform the services during the
28	second academic year; and
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30	WHEREAS, a nine-month employee of an educational institution often
31	falls under the "reasonable assurance" exception, which disqualifies the
32	employee for eligibility for unemployment benefits during the summer months;

35	WHEREAS, nine-month employees of educational institutions are vital
36	employees of educational institutions; and



WHEREAS, waiving the "reasonable assurance" clause would greatly assist our educational support professionals, including without limitation bus drivers, cafeteria workers and paraprofessionals, during the summer months, NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-FIFTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN: THAT the General Assembly urges the Arkansas congressional delegation to propose an amendment to the Federal Unemployment Tax Act to waive the "reasonable assurance" clause to authorize hourly nine-month employees to be eligible for unemployment benefits during the summer. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT upon its adoption, a copy of this resolution be transmitted to the Arkansas congressional delegation by the Secretary of the Senate.
