8	SECTION 1. INTENT OF AMENDMENT. It is the intent of this amendment to		
9	the Arkansas Constitution to protect the right to keep and bear arms granted		
10	under the Arkansas Constitution.

12	SECTION 2. Arkansas Constitution, Article 2, § 5, is amended to read		
13	as follows:		
14	$\S$ 5. Right to <u>keep and</u> bear arms.		
15	(a) The citizens of this State shall have the right to keep and bear		
16	arms, for:		
17	(1) their Their common defense;		
18	(2) Lawful hunting and recreational use; and		
19	(3) Any other lawful purpose.		
20	(b) The right to keep and bear arms under subsection (a) of this		
21	section includes without limitation the possession and use of:		
22	(1) Ammunition;		
23	(2) Firearm accessories; and		
24	(3) Firearm components.		
25	(c) The right to keep and bear arms under subsection (a) of this		
26	section is a natural, fundamental, and individual right that shall not be		
27	infringed.

29	SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This amendment to the Arkansas		
30	Constitution is effective on and after January 1, 2027.
