INTENT OF AMENDMENT. It is the intent of this amendment to 7 the Arkansas Constitution to protect the right to keep and bear arms granted 8 under the Arkansas Constitution. 9 10 SECTION 2. Arkansas Constitution, Article 2, § 5, is amended to read as follows: 11 12 § 5.
