35 shall report to the Legislative Council all amounts carried forward by the
36 September meeting of the Legislative Council or the Joint Budget Committee

1 meeting which report shall include the name of the agency, board, commission,
2 or institution and the amount of funding carried forward, the program name or
3 line item and the funding source; and

4 (2) The Department of Corrections - Division of Correction shall provide a
5 written report to the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee
6 containing all information set forth in subdivision (b)(1) of this section no
7 later than thirty (30) days prior to the time the Department presents its
8 budget request to the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, or both;
9 and

10 (3) Thereupon, the Department of Finance and Administration shall include
11 all information obtained in subdivision (b)(2) of this section in the budget
12 manuals.

13 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
14 ~~2025~~ 2026 through June 30, ~~2026~~ 2027.

15
16 SECTION 30. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
17 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
18 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
19 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
20 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
21 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
22 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
23 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
24 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

25
26 SECTION 31. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
27 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
28 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
29 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
30 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
31 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
32 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
33 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

34
35 SECTION 32. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
36 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits

1 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
2 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2026 is essential to the operation of
3 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
4 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
5 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2026 could work irreparable harm
6 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
7 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
8 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
9 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2026.
