8 **SENATE RESOLUTION**

9 TO RECOGNIZE THE LEAGUE OF WOMEN VOTERS OF ARKANSAS  
10 FOR ITS LONGSTANDING LEADERSHIP IN CIVIC ENGAGEMENT,  
11 VOTER EDUCATION, AND SERVICE TO THE STATE OF  
12 ARKANSAS, AND TO RECOGNIZE LEAGUE DAY AT THE CAPITOL.

16 TO RECOGNIZE THE LEAGUE OF WOMEN VOTERS  
17 OF ARKANSAS FOR ITS LONGSTANDING  
18 LEADERSHIP IN CIVIC ENGAGEMENT, VOTER  
19 EDUCATION, AND SERVICE TO THE STATE OF  
20 ARKANSAS, AND TO RECOGNIZE LEAGUE DAY AT  
21 THE CAPITOL.

23 WHEREAS, the League of Women Voters was founded in 1920, six (6) months  
24 prior to the ratification of the Nineteenth Amendment to the United States  
25 Constitution, to encourage informed and active participation in government;  
26 and

27  
28 WHEREAS, the League of Women Voters of Arkansas traces its roots to the  
29 state's early equal suffrage movement and has, for more than seventy (70)  
30 years since its reestablishment in 1953, served the people of Arkansas  
31 through grassroots, nonpartisan civic engagement; and

33 WHEREAS, the League of Women Voters of Arkansas is a nonpartisan  
34 organization that neither supports nor opposes candidates or political  
35 parties and is dedicated to empowering voters and strengthening democracy  
36 through education, advocacy, and community engagement; and

2           WHEREAS, a strong democracy depends on informed and active  
3 participation by citizens and a continued commitment to transparency, civic  
4 education, and public engagement; and

6           WHEREAS, the League of Women Voters of Arkansas supports civic  
7 understanding by educating the public on Arkansas government, voting laws,  
8 and public policy issues, and by encouraging constructive dialogue and  
9 engagement with elected officials; and  
10

11           WHEREAS, the League of Women Voters of Arkansas continues to expand its  
12 reach across communities large and small, working to grow membership,  
13 increase civic participation, and build a more inclusive and representative  
14 democracy; and  
15

16           WHEREAS, the League of Women Voters of Arkansas hosts League Day at the  
17 Capitol, an event that brings members from across the state to observe the  
18 legislative process and engage with their elected officials; and  
19

20           WHEREAS, events such as League Day at the Capitol provide an  
21 opportunity for Arkansans from across the state to observe the legislative  
22 process, engage with their elected officials, and gain a deeper understanding  
23 of state government,

25 NOW THEREFORE,

26 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-FIFTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE  
27 STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
28

29           THAT the Senate recognize the League of Women Voters of Arkansas for  
30 its enduring contributions to voter education, nonpartisan civic engagement,  
31 and the strengthening of democracy in the State of Arkansas.  
32

33 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Senate commend the members and volunteers of  
34 the League of Women Voters of Arkansas for their continued dedication to  
35 empowering voters and promoting participation in government.
