The Impact of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act on Educational Adequacy in the State of Arkansas

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Executive Summary

The American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA) will significantly affect the level of federal education funding provided to the state of Arkansas. This report presents the additional federal funding available for education programs based on the Recovery Act. A review of the funds received, funds expended, and a discussion of how the Recovery Act funds will impact the State's educational adequacy is also included.

The Recovery Act will provide additional funding to the state of Arkansas for the following elementary and secondary education programs:

- Title I-A Grants to Local Education Agencies
- Title I School Improvement Grants
- Grants for Education Technology
- Grants for Individuals with Disabilities Education Act
- Education for Homeless Children and Youth Grant
- School Lunch Equipment Grants
- Race to the Top Funds
- State Fiscal Stabilization Funds

A short description of each program is contained within the report. **Table 1** lists each program, the funds received to date, and the total funding anticipated for Arkansas schools. **Table 2** lists the funds Arkansas school districts have expended to date on Recovery Act related projects.

Appendix A provides school-district level funding allocations for the Recovery Act funds that have been disbursed to date. These funds have been allocated to the Arkansas Department of Education (ADE) and have been released to the districts on a reimbursement basis.

Elementary & Secondary School Recovery Act Grant Programs

Title I-A Grants to Local Education Agencies currently provide supplementary educational related services to low-achieving and other pupils attending pre-kindergarten through the 12th grade. These grants are targeted towards schools with high concentrations of pupils from low-income families. These funds support programs such as extra instruction in reading and mathematics, as well as special preschool, after-school, and summer programs to extend and reinforce the regular school curriculum (U.S.D.O.E., 2009).

Title I School Improvement Grants will provide additional funding for the modernization, renovation, and repair of existing schools. These grants are targeted towards schools with high concentrations of students from low-income families (U.S.D.O.E., 2009).

Education Technology Grants are provided to state educational agencies and local educational agencies to increase access to educational technology, support the integration of technology into instruction, enhance technological literacy, and support technology-related professional development of teachers (U.S.D.O.E., 2009).

Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) Grants provide additional support for special education and related services for children with disabilities. These grants can be used for obtaining state-of-the art assistive technology devices, providing professional development for special education teachers, expanding the capacity to collect and use data to improve teaching and learning, expanding the availability and range of inclusive placement options for preschoolers with disabilities, and hiring transition coordinators to develop job placements for youths with disabilities (U.S.D.O.E., 2009).

Education for Homeless Children and Youth Program is designed to address the problems that homeless children and youth have faced in enrolling, attending, and succeeding in school. These funds will be used to provide school supplies, clothing, and other school-related necessities for homeless children (U.S.D.O.E., 2009).

School Lunch Equipment Program - This program will provide assistance to schools for the purchase of lunch room equipment through the National School Lunch Program (USDA, 2009).

Race to the Top is a competitive grant program designed to encourage and reward states that are creating the conditions for education innovation and reform. These grants are targeted towards states that are achieving significant improvements in student outcomes, closing achievement gaps, improving high school graduation rates, ensuring student preparation for success in college and careers, and implementing ambitious plans in four core education reform areas:

- 1) Adopting standards and assessments that prepare students to succeed in college and the workplace and to compete in the global economy;
- 2) Building data systems that measure student growth and success, and inform teachers and principals about how they can improve instruction;
- 3) Recruiting, developing, rewarding, and retaining effective teachers and principals, especially where they are needed most; and
- 4) Turning around the lowest-achieving schools (U.S.D.O.E., 2009).

State Fiscal Stabilization Funds (Education Portion) is a special grant program established under the ARRA. This fund will contribute to both government services and education programs. In accordance with the Recovery Act, Arkansas continues to fund education above the FY2006 level, thus the State has distributed these funds through the federal Title I allocation formula to the LEAs in accordance with the Recovery Act (H.R. 1, 2009).

The Local Educational Agencies may use these subgrants for any purpose provided by the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA), the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA), or the Perkins Act (Technical Education), or for modernization, renovation and repair of K-12 facilities, so long as the funds are not used for administration, maintenance costs, stadiums or vehicles.

Funds Currently Received by Arkansas Districts

The Recovery Act education programs will contribute an estimated additional \$576,056,602 in federal aid to Arkansas's elementary and secondary schools. **Table 1** below presents the funds received by Arkansas school districts as of January 4, 2010. The estimated total funds column represents the total education funds from the Recovery Act allocated to Arkansas schools. For funding information pertaining to a specific school district, see **Appendix A**.

Funds Expended by Arkansas Districts

To date, a total of \$124,434,901 has been expended by Arkansas school districts on Recovery Act related projects. It should be noted that these Recovery Act programs operate on a reimbursement basis, thus the funds in the column above are less than the total expenses listed below.

In order to classify Recovery Act expenditures, the Arkansas Department of Education has developed nine program codes by which each expense can be classified. A brief description of each expenditure item is included on the next page. **Table 2** lists each program and the funds expended as of December 19, 2009 for education-related Recovery Act projects. For expenditure information pertaining to a specific district see **Appendix B**.

Buildings and Additions to Buildings include any expense of \$2,500 or greater to add additional square footage to an existing school facility or construct a new facility that will be used for academic purposes.

Major Renovations are expenses of \$2,500 or greater relating to the remodeling of a current school facility that is used for academic purposes.

Equipment includes any school equipment to support student services such as cafeteria equipment purchased under the school lunch equipment program.

Vehicles expenses relate to the purchase or upgrade of existing school vehicles with a value of \$2,500 or greater. Only IDEA funds may be used to purchase buses for special education students.

Technology, Hardware, and Software expenses include technology products of \$2,500 or greater that will be used for academic purposes.

Infrastructure expenses are funds expended relating to assets such as roads, bridges, tunnels, water, and sewer systems.

Direct Services Provided to Students are expenses relating to services directly provided to students, such as after-school or summer programs.

Professional Contracted Services expenses relate to contracted services such as those provided by architects, engineers, and construction managers.

All Other expenses relate to expenditures not covered by another category, such as administrative and indirect costs and capital expenses less than \$2,500.

Program Code Errors are expenses that are reported by districts incorrectly. Under current ADE policy, if these miscoded expenses are not recoded properly, the district may not be reimbursed for these expenses.

Arkansas Jobs Saved/Created

One of the main goals of the Recovery Act program is to create or save jobs. According to the Arkansas Office of Recovery and Reinvestment, within the State of Arkansas the total number of jobs saved or created through the 3rd quarter of 2009 was 2,634 (Arkansas, 2009). The number of jobs saved or created that are directly tied to Recovery Act education programs is 731 (U.S.D.O.E., 2009). The table below breaks-down the total number of jobs saved/created by each Recovery Act program.

Potential Impact of the Recovery Act on Educational Adequacy

The Recovery Act allows school districts to use the federal funding to pay for items already funded through the state education Matrix. For example, the state foundation funding includes \$205 per student for technology-related expenses, but districts can also use their Recovery Act funds to pay for those technology needs. Because the line item amounts in the state's foundation funding Matrix were established only to determine an overall level of foundation funding and are not mandated levels of expenditures, school districts may shift some foundation funding from one matrix line item to another. The following sections describe the possible Matrix categories where school district expenditures can be made using Recovery Act funds.

- **Technology:** Within this Matrix item, districts can use Recovery Act funds to purchase and maintain computers and instructional software.

Ex: The Mountain Home School District will be purchasing student and teacher computers for Pinkston Middle School to enhance their workforce classrooms (ADE, 2009).

- **Instructional Materials:** Within this Matrix item, districts can use Recovery Act funds for pedagogical materials that provide direct assistance to students.

Ex: Marked Tree Elementary School plans to use some Recovery Act funds to purchase manipulatives, books, and literacy materials (ADE, 2009).

- Professional Development: This Matrix item will be affected by Title I Recovery Act funds that allow for professional development expenses.

Ex: The Bryant School District will use a portion of their Title I funds for a "Do the Math" professional development program (ADE, 2009).

- Transportation: This Matrix item is impacted by the Recovery Act funds to address transportation needs in the form of buses for special education students.

Ex: The Cabot School District will be using IDEA funds to purchase two additional handicapped accessible buses to enhance the district's specialized bus routes (ADE, 2009).

The Recovery Act funds are one-time funds that should not affect current or future foundation funding levels. Federal law — Title I-A of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) and Part B of the Individuals with Disabilities Act (IDEA) — requires Recovery Act funding to supplement not supplant other funds designated for ESEA and IDEA programs. And as recognized by the *Lake View* court, constitutional compliance requires the General Assembly to study, review, and adjust that overall level of funding, including an assessment of available revenues, surplus funds, and expenditures by the school districts (Lake View, 2005). In other words, the General Assembly cannot adjust the foundation formula without evidence showing it's warranted. The General Assembly's next biennial expenditure analysis of the foundation funding matrix line items will need to consider the schools' current spending as a one-time alteration in typical school spending patterns.

Potential Impact of the Recovery Act on Educational Facilities Funds

In addition to the impact of Recovery Act funds on the Education Matrix, some facilities expenditures may be affected. According to the Arkansas Department of Academic Facilities and Transportation, there are currently 167 new construction projects in progress funded by the Recovery Act (2010). As a result, there may be a decreased demand in facilities funds throughout the end of 2011 when the Recovery Act funds must be expended.

Ex: The Gravette School District will be using some of the State Fiscal Stabilization Funds for renovations to their Lion Pride Academy building. This renovation would add additional classroom space for ALE students (ADE, 2009).
