COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 3214

AN ACT ENTITLED THE "FEDERAL ABORTION-MANDATE OPT-OUT ACT";

TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF FEDERAL FUNDS TO PAY FOR ELECTIVE ABORTIONS

COVERED BY PRIVATE INSURANCE IN THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI THROUGH A

HEALTH CARE EXCHANGE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 **SECTION 1.** Title. This act may be known and cited as the
- 7 "Federal Abortion-Mandate Opt-Out Act."
- 8 SECTION 2. Legislative findings and purposes. (1) The
- 9 Legislature of the State of Mississippi finds that Section 1303 of
- 10 the federal Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act, states are
- 11 explicitly permitted to pass laws prohibiting qualified health
- 12 plans offered through an exchange in their state from offering
- 13 abortion coverage.
- 14 (2) It is the purpose of this act to affirmatively opt out
- 15 of allowing qualified health plans that cover abortions to
- 16 participate in exchanges within the State of Mississippi.
- 17 **SECTION 3. Opt-Out.** (1) No abortion coverage may be
- 18 provided by a qualified health plan offered through an exchange
- 19 created pursuant to the federal Patient Protection and Affordable
- 20 Care Act within the State of Mississippi.
- 21 (2) This limitation shall not apply to an abortion performed
- 22 (a) when the life of the mother is endangered by a physical
- 23 disorder, physical illness or physical injury, including a
- 24 life-endangering physical condition caused by or arising from the
- 25 pregnancy itself, or (b) when the pregnancy is the result of an
- 26 alleged act of rape or incest. The physician is required to
- 27 maintain sufficient documentation in the medical record that

- 28 supports the medical necessity for the abortion for one of the
- 29 reasons outlined in this subsection (2).
- 30 **SECTION 4.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 31 and after its passage.
