19 WHEREAS, on March 6, 1947, the Bureau of Legislative Research was
20 created as part of the same legislation that created the Legislative Council;
21 and

23 WHEREAS, the Bureau of Legislative Research began with only a director,
24 a stenographer, and a couple of administrative assistants to assist the
25 legislature; and

27 WHEREAS, the Bureau of Legislative Research was originally created for
28 a twenty (20) year period and its original duties included providing
29 legislative services to the Legislative Council, submitting itemized budgets
30 for each state agency, drafting bills with the assistance of the University
31 of Arkansas School of Law, and assisting the Governor in acquiring factual
32 information concerning various matters; and

34 WHEREAS, since its creation seventy-five (75) years ago, the Bureau of
35 Legislative Research has faithfully served the General Assembly in supporting
36 the mission of the General Assembly,
