16	WHEREAS, dating back to the American Revolution, African Americans have
17	played key roles in the history and success of the United States military;
18	and

20	WHEREAS, there are more than two million (2,000,000) African American
21	veterans in the United States; and
22	
23	WHEREAS, America's story is written in the sweat and blood of military
24	heroism, valor, and service; and
25	
26	WHEREAS, African Americans have stood along their diverse counterparts
27	training and fighting for the principles of justice, freedom, and democracy;

29	LHEDEAC the let Dhade Telend Deciment the first Continental Association
30 31	WHEREAS, the 1st Rhode Island Regiment, the first Continental Army unit largely comprised of Black New Englanders showcased African Americans' skill
32	as soldiers and commitment to their brethren on the battlefield; and
33	as solutions and commitment to their pretimen on the pattierners, and
34	WHEREAS, just over one hundred (100) years ago during World War I, the
35	Harlem Hellfighters battled hostile forces abroad and racism at home,
36	demonstrating a remarkable commitment to this country; and

2	WHEREAS, Beginning in 1941, the nine hundred twenty-six (926) all-black
3	Tuskegee Airmen carried out hundreds of escort missions during World War II,
4	never losing a single plane to the enemy; and
5	
6	WHEREAS, African American veterans have used the experience and
7	discipline they acquired in the military to attain prominent positions in the
8	civilian world including David Robinson, James Earl Jones, Arkansas native
9	Sheryl Underwood, and Morgan Freeman; and
10	
11	WHEREAS, John Hanks Alexander, from Arkansas, was the very first
12	African American in United States history to hold a regular command position
13	as the Troop Commander of B Troop, 9th Cavalry,
14	
15	NOW THEREFORE,
16	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-FOURTH GENERAL
17	ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
18	
19	THAT the House of Representatives celebrate Black Veterans Month during
20	the month of February, 2023, and recognize the sacrifices and contributions
21	made by African American veterans.
